Description

The proposed project named "Africa Without Myths" develops teachers capacity to anchor development education into the formal education sector and contributes to raising public awareness of development issues. It also increases the capacity of the pupils ' competencies at secondary schools, in particular, competencies - to promote intercultural dialogue and break stereotypes between Slovak and Kenyan pupils, as well as to understand their (inter)connection to the Global South. The project will foster simultaneous inclusion of Global Learning (GL) on several subjects and decrease the level of stereotypes among Slovak pupils about issues related to Global South, particularly to Sub-Saharan Africa. This will help students approach issues of importance from different angles therefore developing their critical understanding of the relations linking our societies with the rest of the world and understanding of global interdependencies. The overall objective of the action is to increase awareness of Slovak society about importance of development education and development assistance by implementing activities at Slovak secondary schools. The specific objectives are: 1. To embed specific topics of development education into secondary school programs and projects, through better understanding of issues related to Sub-Saharan Africa. 2. Among pupils of Slovak secondary schools will reach better understanding of principles and goals of Slovak Official Development Assistance in Sub-Saharan Africa on an example of Kenya. 3. To strengthen the intercultural dialogue and break stereotypes among Slovak pupils and to establish mutual cooperation (twinning) between Slovak and Kenyan secondary schools. The expected results of the action are: 1. . Methodological materials for secondary schools - in order to integrate development education into education programs and to implement them in the educational projects. The toolkit will consist on two parts - Informative and methodological, both focused on the topic of" Africa - myths and facts". 2. Manual for teachers informing and giving ideas and sharing best practices of how to organize online-video conferences. 3. Training for 16 teachers from 8 schools which will be focused on the
