Description

Anti-malnutrition center in Kibeho is run by Sisters Missionaries of St. Vincent Pallotti as a part of a network of center, which are dedicated to help the poorest people in Rwanda. The volunteer will be helping the social worker with fulfillment of the main goals of the center during his stay. Aim of the anti-malnutrition center is to look for under nourished children from the poorest families, to provide rehabilitation program for them and their mothers and to offer complex specialized education on whether health or spreading these ideas.
