#### Description

The aim of this project is to strengthen the coordination, implementation and managerial capacities of Slovak NGDO Platform's (PMVRO) member organizations active in the area of development cooperation, humanitarian aid and global education. Further aims are also to strengthen their competitiveness in the international environment as well as improve their joint networking and cooperation capabilities with other relevant actors mostly with the aim of making the official development aid of the Slovak Republic more efficient. The project will be implemented primarily in the geographic boundaries of Slovak Republic but will also trickle down into the international arena. The target groups of the project are the PMVRO members (27) as well as the development experts along with broad public. The specific goal of the project is to strengthen the capacities of PMVRO member organizations in implementing projects fitting their focus, as well as in relation to increasing their influence on national and European development policies and also in relation to winning support of the expert and general public. The fulfillment of this goal will materialize in the following 3 outcomes. The first is the raise in expertise, knowledge and awareness of 27 CSOs in areas of development cooperation, humanitarian aid and global education through the following activities: 1.1.1. trainings, conferences and other educational events for 4 CSO workers 1.1.2. organizing and event in Slovakia - which would consist of a simulation of humanitarian aid praxis (15 people from CSOs present, as well as 100 general public attendees), 1.1.3. facilitation of an information flow from global and European levels to the national level (3 experts involved in working structures of CONCORD), 1.1.4. facilitation of 5 expert working groups (4 working groups, PMVRO board, Members Assembly for 27 CSOs, all together guided by 4 experts). The second outcome will be the production of expert policy inputs and recommendations regarding development cooperation, humanitarian aid and global education strategic policy documents on the national as well as the EU level, through the following activities: 1.2.1. analysis and preparation of background documents and recommendations
